A few years ago, several women in Bolivia took out a \$300 loan provided through World Vision. They received training and started a small business making dresses, school bags and other things. Today, they earn about \$1,500 a month selling these items — a lot of money when you're used to making a dollar a day. They have since repaid their loan, which went back into a general fund to help other hard-working families. This is how your gift of a small loan can change lives for generations.

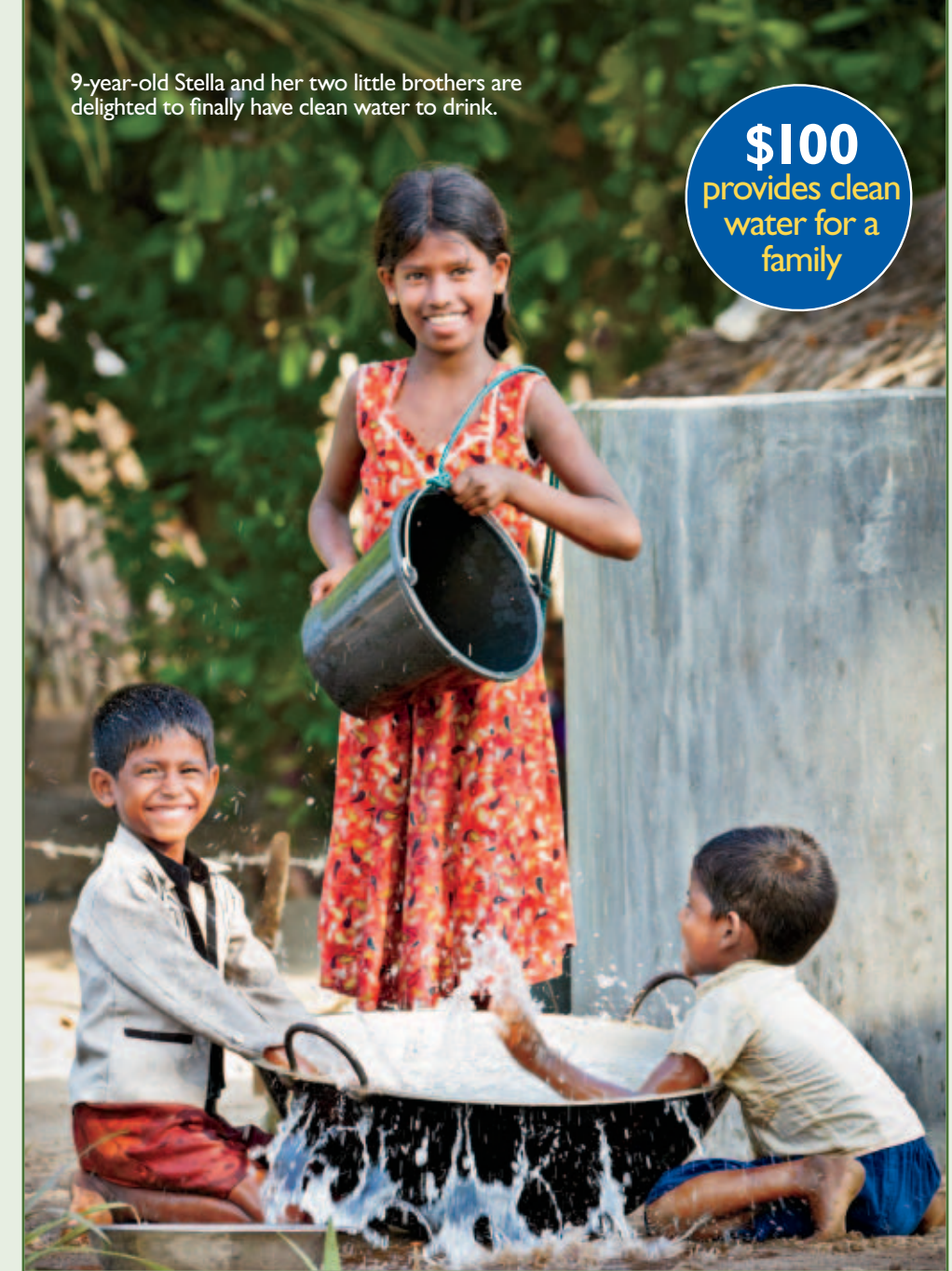

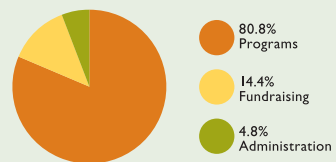
